objective of education: empowering students to think and learn independently by providing them with the essential tools of learning.

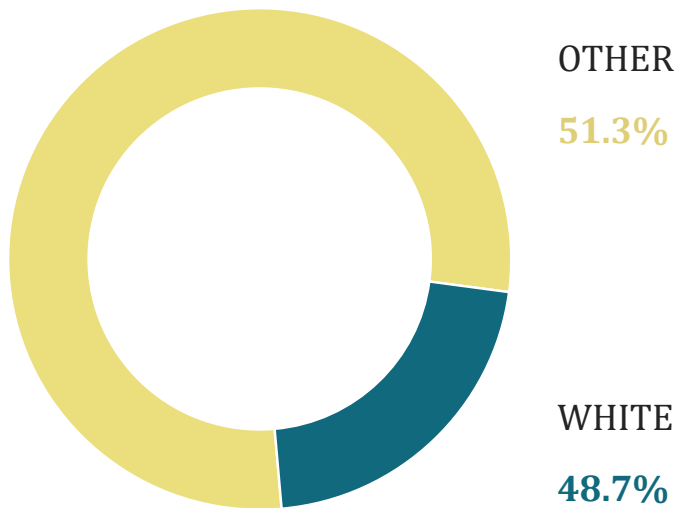

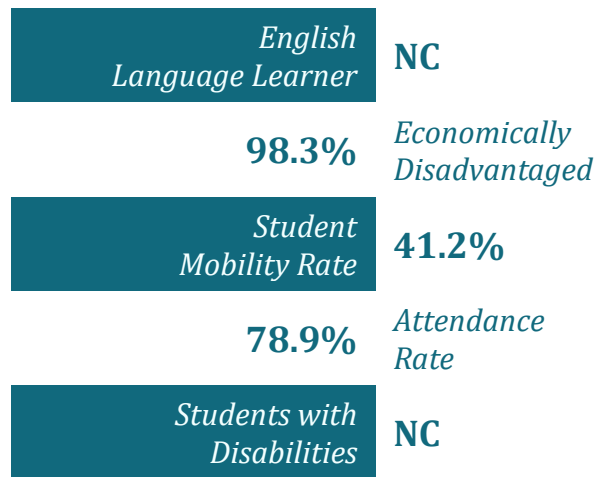

Progress towards Goals

Prior **attendance** was not reported accurately in 2024, and a new baseline will be established using the 2025 data of **78.9%**. Walkthroughs are being conducted weekly for each teacher using **SchoolMint Grow**. Teachers are provided with immediate feedback based on an established set of criteria, with conferences held weekly to discuss. In **Reading**, **61%** of students demonstrated progress at or above the annual typical growth rate. In **Math**, **75%** of students demonstrated progress at or above the annual typical growth rate.

Our Academic Goals

- 1 By FY2028, **Attendance** will increase **50.0%**.
- 2 By FY2028, **Instructional Coherence** will increase by **20.0%** using a Walkthrough Instrument.
- 3 By FY2028, **Reading/Literacy** will increase **20.0%** using iReady.

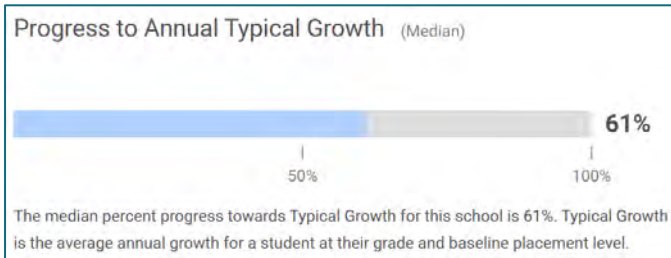

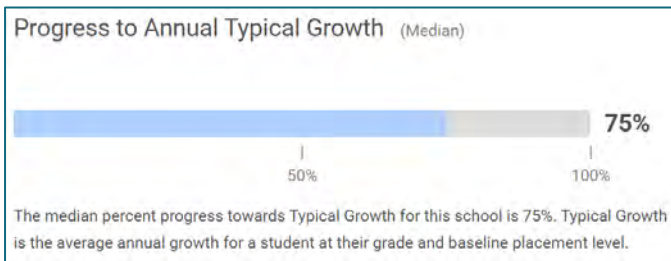




iReady Data Reading
